About the Program

These positions provide tuition benefit program hours and are benefits eligible during the fall/spring semester, but summer positions are paid hourly with limited benefits eligibility. Department Overview

The Media Library contains the UNT Libraries' non-print, audiovisual, tabletop games, and video games collections. The mission of the UNT Media Library is to support the instructional and research needs of UNT faculty, staff, and students by collecting, maintaining, and providing access to media materials that represent all academic disciplines and all genres of film.

Position Description

The Statistics and Data Analytics Graduate Research Assistant will assist the Media Library Head and the Media Library Services and Collections Specialist in collecting and interpreting statistics to inform decision making in services and research support. The GRA will utilize software (Power BI, Microsoft Excel, Sierra, etc.) to track and analyze statistics related to services in circulation, reference, and instruction. They will create monthly reports and lead meetings to explain their findings.

Tasks include but are not limited to:

Data Collection & Management:

- Organize, clean, and prepare data for analysis
- Maintain secure storage of project materials and datasets

Data Analysis & Reporting:

- Assist with preliminary quantitative and qualitative analysis
- Create visualizations (tables, charts, graphs) for reports and presentations
- Draft sections of progress reports and summaries for Media staff and faculty review
- Assist in final project deliverables for library stakeholders

Hours and Location

Hours: 20 hours per week

Schedules are flexible and agreed upon mutually between the employee and supervisor.

The Media Library is located on the second floor of Willis Library.

Duration

Spring 2026. Dependent upon funding summer employment may also be available.

Minimum Qualifications

You must be a full-time graduate student. You should also possess these qualifications:

- Experience creating reports, dashboards, or data visualizations for decision-making
- Familiarity with tools such as Excel, SQL, R, or Python
- Familiarity with advanced analytics tools (Power Bi, Tableau, etc.)
- Strong communication skills to simplify complex findings for non-technical stakeholders

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience working collaboratively
- Familiarity with data privacy regulations and compliance practices

Pay Rate

Pay rate will depend on student's progression in their graduate program.
